I ACKNOWLEDGE AND AFFIRM THAT THE FOLLOWING LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM PROVISIONS WERE EXPLAINED IN DETAIL:

1. Our Firm's duty to pay prevailing wages under Labor Code Section 1770 et seq.	2. Our Firm has a duty to employ registered apprentices on the Public works project under Labor Code Section 1777.5.
3. Our firm is aware of the penalties for failure to pay prevailing wages and employ apprentices under Labor Code Sections 1775 and 1777.7.	4. Our Firm is required to keep and submit copies upon request of certified payroll records and are aware of the penalties for failure to do so under Labor Code Section 1776 et seq. All contractors who perform work, even if their portion of work is less than one half of one percent, are to submit Certified Payroll Records.
5. Our Firm is aware of the prohibition against employment discrimination under Labor Code Sections 1735 and 1777.6., the Government Code, and Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.	6. There is a prohibition against accepting or extracting Kickbacks from employee wages under Labor Code Section 1778.
7. There is a prohibition against accepting fees for registering any person for public work under Labor Code Section 1779; or for filling work orders on public works under Labor Code Section 1780.	8. Our Company has listed all subcontractors pursuant to the Public Contract Code Section 4100 et seq.
9. Our Company is properly licensed by the State of California and will ensure that all of our subcontractors are properly licensed by the State of California and are aware of the penalty for employing workers while unlicensed under Labor Code Section 1021 & California Contractors License Law, found at Business and Professions Code Section 7000 et seq.	10. There is a prohibition against unfair competition under Business and Professions Code Section 17200-17208.
11. Our company is properly insured for Workers Compensation under Labor Code Section 1861.	12. Our company and its employees will abide by the Occupational, Safety and Health laws and regulations that apply to the particular construction project.
13. There is a Federal Prohibition against hiring undocumented workers and the requirement to secure proof of eligibility/citizenship from all workers.	14. The requirement to provide itemized wage statements to employees under Labor Code Section 226.
15. Contractors and subcontractors will need to be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations in order to 1) bid or be listed on a bid for a public works project on or after March 1, 2015, or 2) work on a public works project awarded on or after April 1, 2015.	16. For all new projects awarded on or after April 1, 2015, contractors and subcontractors must also furnish electronic certified payroll records to the Labor Commissioner (aka Division of Labor Standards Enforcement).
