

# Hort - Asphalt Slurry 2024 Scope of Work

## General Items:

- Summer working hours shall be 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. or on an agreed upon time between the contractor and the district.
- Construction schedule provided by BCSD. See Attachment "B"
- Apply two coats of slurry with slurry buggy over at each site.
- Thoroughly clean the asphalt prior to the slurry application.
- Slurry material not to be greater than 25%.
- No line bleed through from existing striping.
- Contractor will redo all striping covered by the slurry to match existing layouts after the asphalt slurry work.
- Prior to asphalt slurry placement, contractor to field verify and confirm layout of all markings on the pavement by field measurements and pictures.
- See Attachment "A" for area to receive the slurry coat. Note: Contractor shall be responsible for all quantities and measurements.

## Alternate:

- Provide an alternate bid to patch asphalt cracks ½" and larger, potholes prior to the slurry application. Note: Project will be awarded on the base bid only.

# Protection:

• The Contractor shall always take all precautions to avoid damaging structures around the work area. The Contractor shall be responsible for, and liable for, all damage or ill effects caused by a lack of adequate protection against the hazards associated with their work. The Contractor shall carry adequate insurance and he shall protect the district from all liens or damages arising from or caused by his work.

## Disposal:

• The Contractor shall thoroughly clean the area as work progresses. After completion of work, the Contractor shall remove all debris resulting from this work and shall remove all splatters or spills from other surfaces adjacent to the work. The buildings and the site premises shall be left in a condition that is acceptable to the district.
