Immersion Testing

30-Day Immersion Testing: No visible deterioration when tested in 5% Caustic Potash, 5% Hydrochloric Acid, 5% Sulfuric Acid, and 5% saturated Hydrogen Sulfide.

One Year Immersion Testing: No visible deterioration when tested in 5% Formaldehyde, 5% Formic Acid, 5% Sulfuric Acid, 5% Hydrochloric Acid, 5% Sodium Hydroxide, 5% Hydrogen Sulfide, and 5% Potassium Hydroxide.

Installation Guidelines

The following procedures should be followed for optimum sealant performance.

- Clean the upper and lower joint surface with a stiff bristle brush.
- Remove any dirt, debris, flashing, or concrete high points, which could keep the joint from coming together.
- If necessary, a joint primer can be applied to improve sealant adhesion. Allow the primer to dry before placing sealant.
- DO NOT PLACE ANY JOINTS WITHIN 12" OF A CORNER.
- Join the sealant into one continuous strand by kneading the ends together where they meet. Do not stretch the sealant.
- A minimum compression of 50% is required. Greater than 50% compression is optimal. It may take 15-20 minutes for the sealant to fully compress depending on the ambient temperature and the weight being applied.

Tools To Make The Job Simple

Press Fit Cam Pin

Requires a one time welding of bushing flush with concrete side of inner form. Simply insert cam pin (coated with form oil) and lock into place for each casting. To remove cam pin, unlock and strike with sledge hammer. Keep cam pin clean and free of concrete to insure accurate molding of hole. Concrete should be cured to develop a minimum comprehensive strength of 3000 psi before installing step.

Drilling

For installing steps in new or old concrete, use a heavy duty drill to drill two parallel holes for the following steps...

PS1-PF	1" hole	10" on center	3-3/4" deep
PS2-PF	1" hole	13" on center	3-3/4" deep
PS2-PFS	1" hole	13" on center	3-3/4" deep
PS2-PFSL	1-1/4" hole	13" on center	3-1/2" dcep
PS5-PF	I" hole	II" on center	3-3/4" deep
PS3-PFC	t" hole	16" on center	3-3/4" deep

Installation as quick as 1-2-3


A sledge hammer is all you need to install the M.A. "Press Fit" manhole step. Drive the step in a minimum 3 inches... no grout... that's all... and best of all the step will last as long as the manhole you install it in. With good forming and installation practices, the step will resist pullout forces in excess of ASTM standards. The M.A. manhole step is the first step engineered to completely encapsulate a 1/2" steel rod with tough copolypropylene.


For extra profits and customer satisfaction, practice these simple rules.

- 1. Form proper size holes
- 2. Have concrete cured to a min. strength of 3000 PSI
- 3. Drive step to full depth, a minimum 3 inches.
- Use form lubricants only. CAUTION: DO NOT USE GREASE.
